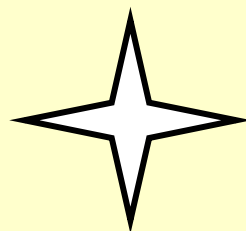
We look after 80 "god-families"

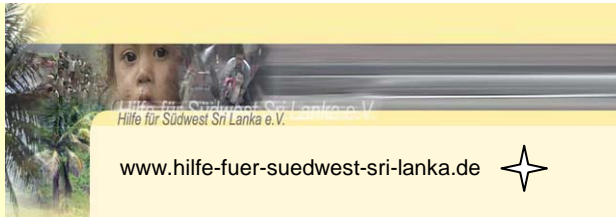


### **Hilfe für Südwest Sri Lanka e.V.**

**A few hundred thousand people lost their houses and their possessions during the terrible floods on 26<sup>th</sup> December 2004.**

On the 06<sup>th</sup> January 2005 the charity "Hilfe für Südwest Sri Lanka e.V." (Help for Southwest Sri Lanka e.V.) was founded. It is meant for the support of the needy in the area as well schools, medical institutions and orphanages in the Southwest of Sri Lanka, especially in the region of Beruwala / Alutgama / Bentota. A lot of its founders have been engaged in this region for a few years. They know the area and can appraise where help is needed most. As all its members work on a honorary basis (all administrative and travel costs are paid for by third parties and are not at the expense of the society) 100% of the donations are for the benefit of the needy.

### What have we achieved with €750 000 until July 2007?

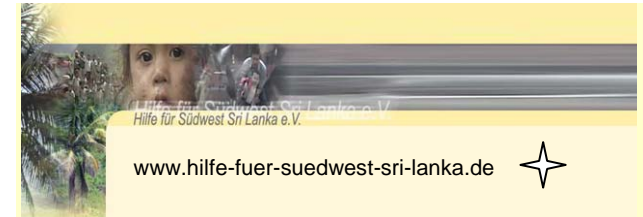
- Construction of 109 wooden houses
- Purchase of 2800 m<sup>2</sup> of property and construction of 10 stone houses, which were handed over to 10 families in October 2005.
- Purchase of small properties for construction of 10 stone houses
- Construction of various stable wood/stone houses
- Purchase of 10 fishing boats and numerous fishing nets
- Electricity for houses
- Construction of 10 wells and 3 wells with a pump
- Construction of various outside toilets
- Renovation and equipments of a primary school in Tangalle
- Support and food supply for a home for the disabled in Galle
- Support of a hospital in Induruwa/Gonegalle and Bentota with medication, technical equipment and repairs
- Built some roofs
- Repairs of various houses
- Purchase of a house for 2 poor fishing families
- 7 heart operations for children
- Financing of 61 eye operations
- Purchase of an audiometer and an eyeanalyser



- Spectacle-days for 2000 eye patients with hand-over of their glasses
- Construction of a dental station in the Bentota-Hospital
- Construction of a Kinder garden in Katukele
- Construction of a mother and child clinic in Beruwala
- Renovation and extension of a mother and child clinic in Kalutara
- Playground for the Maha Induruwa School
- Support of the St. Anthonis Boys School in Panadura with school materials
- Financing of 5 English classes with "Spoken English"
- Support program for the apprenticeship of youngsters
- Erection of a support school for children with out any school diploma
- Erection of a building for the library of the Bentota-Gamini College
- Handover of the school building for the primary school in Panadura
- Order of a two-storied building for the primary schools in Panadura and Bentota respectively

- Equipment (beds, cupboards, tables, chairs, mosquito-nets etc.)
